Southbound on I-5 (from Vancouver, BC)

- 1. Take I-5 to exit 7, I-205 south.
- 2. Take the exit for Highway 14 east.
- 3. Follow steps 4-6 below.

Northbound on I-5 (from Eugene)

- 1. Take I-5 north to I-205.
- 2. Follow I-205 across the Columbia River into Washington.
- 3. Take the exit for Highway 14 east.
- 4. Take exit 8 for 164th.
- 5. Left onto 164th, and drive until you reach Tech Center Drive (light after 15th)
- 6. Right onto Tech Center Drive. Hotel is on your right.

Portland Traffic: if you are coming through or from Portland on Friday, note that afternoon commute traffic is notorious, especially northbound on I-5 toward Vancouver. Traffic jams can be expected on I-5 from about 2pm to 7pm. So we suggest that you take I-205 across the river into Vancouver instead of I-5, and that you plan to arrive in Vancouver earlier in the afternoon if possible.
